



- Norma will help us draft a general strategic plan and then have a more detailed implementation plan.

 - o Jenn felt these are still relevant to the work that we do
- We will be dividing into work groups after the retreat.
- Review previous strategic plan so that we can address the alignment in the specifics of the strategic and the alignment of values, strengths and aspirations. Read the SOAR to remind us of those. Review HB 1510 language as well, which included our community priorities as well.

BLE UPDATES (Information)

Presenter: MaryKate Ryan

- Reference timeline of the project on our website https://www.historicsouthdowntown.org/lightrail
 - July 2022: ST Board voted on further study period for several segments along the BLE segment of the line, identified a West Seattle alternative – that's when it really was split into two separate projects. Ballard Link Extension is our focus.

- October 2022 January 2023: workshops during study period, where a new alternative with the North of CID and South of CID station alternatives came out and retooled where the segments b3egan and end. Originally a CID stop; North station replaces CID station and South Station replaced Midtown Station but part of two different segments.
- o March 2023: ST identified preferred N/S stations. North Station renamed the Midtown Station (where King Count Admin Station). South Station renamed Dearborn Station. But then determined couldn't make South Lake Union Option.
- o Series of workshops in 2024.
- o South DT (Jackson Hub) supported by HSD and workshops will continue to be held there.
- o ST holding a series of information session providing community members about BLE. First held on March 28 on equity, held open house style. Next info session in 4/30, 4-6pm, it will be to discuss regional and local connectivity for N/S stations.
- Landmarking question status around King County Administrative Building and INS Building (part of Chinatown Historic District)

BLE ADVOCACY DISCUSSION (Information)

Presenter: Kathleen Barry Johnson

- Jessa mentioned concern that the SLU segment seems to be getting a lot more attention. Is there a way to strategically utilize our communications folks to keep our name and segment in people's minds?
- Derek asked if we could mobilize our partners or take on meetings with officials with this? We can discuss this at our retreat.
- Kathleen mentioned we're working on an animation that will be showing sample rider coming up from South End to Pill Hill. Or traveler from LS to Airport. To show what that ride looks like because of the "severing of the spine." Madrona Group working on this. Really to show the effects on transit.
- Jenn mentioned we should keep in mind HSD's role in these conversations with partners.
